NATS MEMBER AND STUDENT REGISTRATION

Both Musical Theater and Classical categories will take place on Saturday, April 6, 2024 at the University of Oklahoma School of Music. NATS members are allowed to enter 8 students total across all categories. You may enter an additional student for every first-place winner you had at the 2023 Oklahoma Chapter of NATS and/or at TEXOMA Regional NATS Student Auditions. For Category (CL)15 (Adult :Age 22-99) offered by Oklahoma Chapter of NATS and High School divisions are allowed an unlimited number of entries per member. Please note that Category 15 is designated as COMMENTS ONLY and will not offer final callback or ranking within the division.

JUDGES' MEETING AND ADJUDICATING ASSIGNMENTS

All teachers registering students must be present at the opening judges' meeting and be available to judge for preliminary and final rounds. If teachers are not present and available to judge as assigned, the students they enter will be disqualified. **Please note:** Judging assignments posted on **AuditionNow** may change. Final judging assignments will be announced at the 7:45 a.m. meeting on April 6, 2024.

COPYRIGHT

Please remind your students about the NATS copyright policy, to which we are bound. Students in violation of this policy will be disqualified.

May I use my iPad during my audition?

"Yes, but only for collaborative pianists or by a singer while performing an Oratorio, Mass, Requiem, or Cantata Aria. Singers may hold music scores (on iPads) for these types of arias as is traditional

performance practice. An audition may not restart due to any malfunction of an iPad."

Use of Tablets by Collaborative Pianist

The use of iPads and tablets as musical scores for collaborative pianists during all levels of NATS auditions has been approved and are held to the same standards of copyright as any other musical score used for audition.

For detailed information pertaining to the appropriate usage of tablets please visit the NATS Commonly Asked Copyright Questions for Teachers, Accompanists, and Students document located in the NATS Copyright Resource Center. As long as the singer and pianist affirm that they are in compliance with the NATS Copyright Policy, the pianist may use a personal tablet to display a stored electronic version of sheet music. However, obvious copyright infringement will not be allowed, and may result in disqualification from the competition.

Adjudicators are not copyright investigators. This is solely the job of the Auditions Chairs. If Auditions Chairs see obvious infringement (whether in digital or paper form), they are compelled to address the matter accordingly.

REPERTOIRE CHANGES AND STUDENT CANCELATIONS

Repertoire changes may be updated in **AuditionNow** until system is closed by the Auditions Chairs. If changes must be made after the closing of the registration period, please contact Molly Johnson mjohnson138@uco.edu or Laura Cowan laura.cowan@tulsacc.edu, Oklahoma District Vice Presidents for Student Auditions. They will assist you with any changes or questions regarding repertoire change(s). Please submit all repertoire changes and student cancellations prior to the opening judges' meeting on April 6, 2024.

LOCATING YOUR STUDENTS' AUDITION TIMES

Students and Judging Schedules will be posted in **AuditionNow** following the same process for login that you used to register for the conference. Once you have entered the system, click on "View my Students/Judging Schedule". You will then be able to "View/Print my students schedule" on the right-hand side. This will bring up a new window with all of your judging information and your students' preliminary round times. *Please look over your students' assigned categories carefully and notify the Vice Presidents for Student Auditions or me immediately if you see that your student is in the wrong category.*

ADJUDICATION FORMS

Each student must bring **three copies** of their adjudication form to the preliminary round. You may download and print these forms from **AuditionNow** (auto-filled) or print blank forms and complete them by hand.
